ANA MARÍA CONTENTO is a Professor in Analytical Chemistry at the University of Castilla-La Mancha (Spain) since 2003. She received his PhD from the University of Castilla-La Mancha in 1996. She accomplished Postdoctoral Research Stays in the Spanish National Research Council (CSIC) and in the University of Montpellier (France) developing studies about several methodologies using capillary electrophoresis with laser induced fluorescence detection and validation of analytical methods (mainly spectrophotometric, chromatographic and electrophoretic) for clinical or environmental samples. She has published 50 scientific articles in international journals, 50 communications presented to national and international scientific events. She has directed 5 doctoral theses and 6 master theses. Nowadays she is involved in the Automation, Simplification and Miniaturization of Chemical measurement processes and integration of nanomaterials for environmental and food control parameters in Analytical Nanotechnology.

In terms of teaching, she has taught several courses at the Degree in Chemistry and Technology of Foods and Chemical Engineering. She has also taught at various courses and masters organized by the University of Castilla – La Mancha.
